

How to configure the Edge Browser from Microsoft

1. Open Microsoft Edge



- 2. Click on the three dots in the top right corner to open the settings menu.
- 3. Select "Settings" from the menu.
- 4. Click on "System and performance" in the left-hand menu.
- 5. Toggle on the option that says "Use hardware acceleration when available".

- 6. Click on "Default Browser" in the left-hand menu
- 7. Under "Internet Explorer compatibility", change "Allow sites to be reloaded in Internet Explorer mode (IE mode)" to "Allow"



8. Click "Add" after "Internet Explorer mode pages" and add "http://" + CITREX Ethernet IP, such as http://192.168.5.220
